Event Details:

Parade will take place on the library grounds. In the event of rain, parade will be re-scheduled to July 20th (weather updates will be posted on the HPL Facebook page). All well behaved pets and their families are welcome (see rules below).

All pets entered will receive a ribbon for participation.

Prizes will be awarded for 3 special categories:

- Most Creative Presentation
- Friendliest Pet
- Best Buddies (pet and handler)

Registration is day of. Participants are asked to arrive by 10:10am at the latest for check-in. Parade will start promptly at 10:30am.

Spectators are also encouraged to arrive early and settle into viewing areas along parade route. Camp chairs and blankets are welcome. Please be respectful audience members; do not feed or touch animals without owner's consent.

Parade Rules:

- All pets MUST be on a leash or crated. Dogs may be walked. All other pets (birds, cats, hampsters, etc.) MUST be caged and pulled in a wagon.
- No Flexi-leashes or retractable leashes are allowed during the parade.
- No aggressive animals or any animals in "heat". Well-behaved animals only.
- Dogs, cats, and ferrets are required to have current rabies vaccinations. All other pets must be in good health and have no communicable illnesses.
- Participants are responsible for picking up their pet's waste before, during, and after the parade. Bring the necessary disposable bags and use them.
- One pet per handler.
- All participants younger than 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent/guardian.
- No motorized vehicles outside of mobility aids are allowed on parade route.
- Participants must sign waiver and be checked in by 10:30am.
